A fun event is a safe event We are dedicated to ensuring your safety during this event. Please ensure you read this safety guide. It has been provided for your safety.

Think SAFETY FIRST !

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AT ALL TIMES

Jump Start personnel will be wearing RED T'SHIRTS for easy identification. There will also be Uniformed Guides (ATC cadets) and Jump Start personnel to assist with your orientation to the appropriate areas for parking and to the Jump Start event area. Please ensure that you follow our instructions, or the instructions of the RNZAF at all times. Please remember we are on an active Military base and as such we have very strict rules that MUST be followed. Failure to do so could lead to the cancellation of this and future events. Misconduct of any kind will not be tolerated, and will lead to eviction from base.

SECURITY ID STICKERS

To gain access to the air base, your name MUST be on the "master entry list". Jump Start personnel will issue you with a SECURITY ID STICKER. These MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. These stickers will permit you access to and from base and the event area.

REMAIN IN DESIGNATED AREAS

Once you arrive at the Jump Start event area, you will not be permitted to move around the airbase. You will be permitted access to your vehicle. Visitors cannot 'roam' around base! Stay within the designated event areas at all times.

AIRCRAFT HAZARD

DO NOT APPROACH ANY AIRCRAFT unless instructed to do so by RNZAF staff. NEVER GO FORWARD OF THE AIRCRAFT WING STRUT AT ANY TIME. All other flying activity on base has been restricted during the Jump Start event. Movements of aircraft will not occur whilst the C130 is operating. No other parachute, Glider or model aircraft will operate on the day.

RUNWAY HAZARD

All concrete or tar sealed runways should be treated as if they were busy roads. NEVER CROSS A RUNWAY UNATTENDED. Ensure you are accompanied by either a Jump Start staff member or a uniformed ATC cadet at all times.

PARACHUTE LANDING AREA (DROP ZONE or DZ)

Keep well clear of the Parachute Landing Area. The DZ is a large area to the front of the main viewing area. This area is for the landing parachutes and therefore should be kept clear. Only move out to the DZ if invited to do so by RNZAF or Jump Start personnel.

TOILETS

Portable toilets will be available for your use throughout the day. Adults should supervise children. These are located behind the event hanger area.

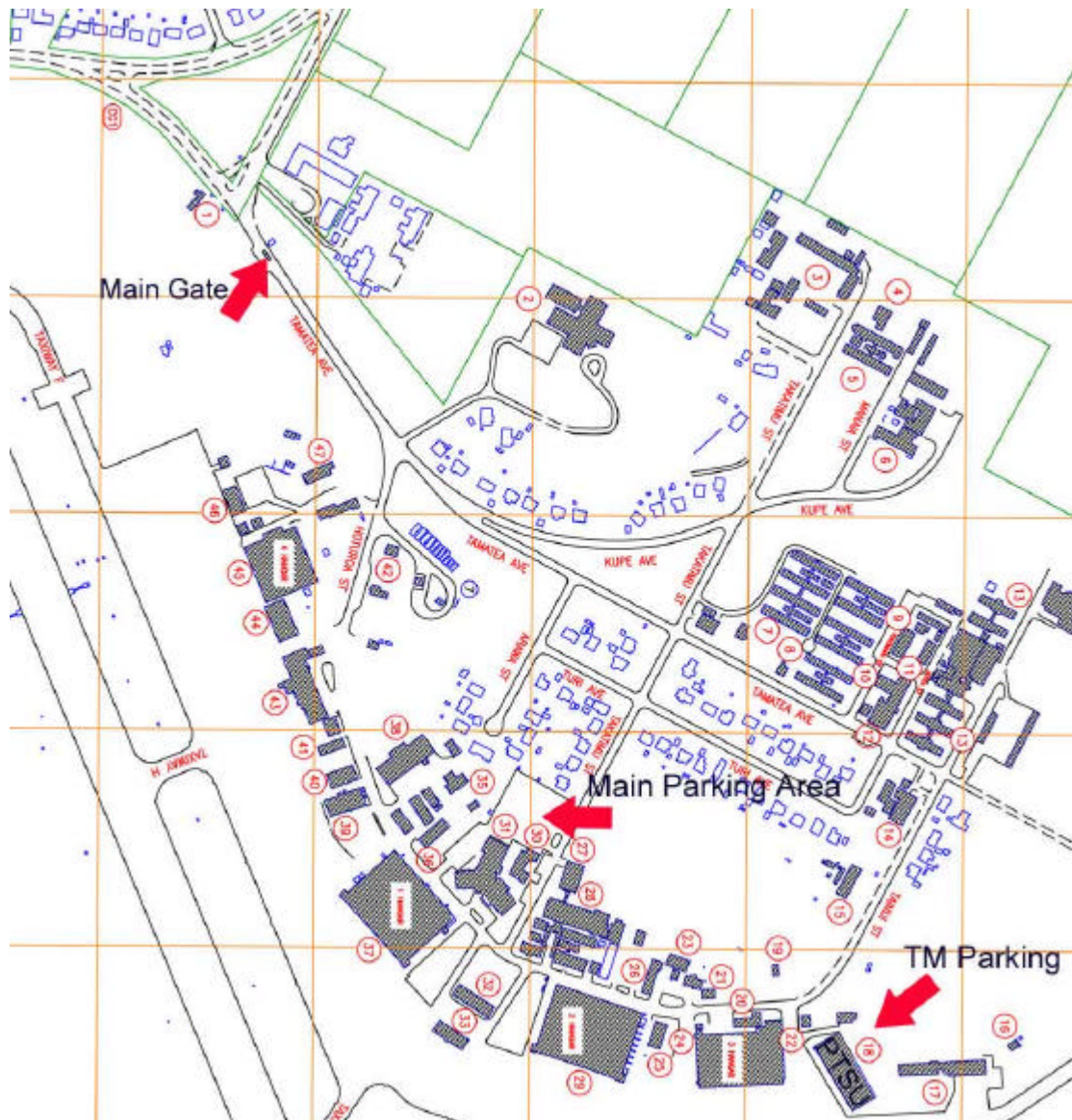
CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES
